Price List

- \$2,440 Ohio Historical Marker **1" text** - same text on both sides
- \$2,520 Ohio Historical Marker 1" text - different text on each side
- \$2,560 Ohio Historical Marker **5/8" text** - same text on both sides
- \$2,730 Ohio Historical Marker 5/8" text - different text on each side
- \$2,040 Ohio Corporate Limit Marker (\$1,800 for each additional marker with identical text)

The Ohio Historical Markers program collaborates with local sponsors of markers to write texts that are concise and that communicate the essence of the person, place, thing, or event being commemorated. Markers with 1 inch texts and fewer words are less expensive than those with smaller texts of 5/8 inches and more words.

Artwork

Custom art work and metal-plate photos can be accommodated at an additional cost. The size and number of images will reduce the number of words on the marker, but sometimes a picture is worth a thousand words! Please allow extra time for production if artwork is included. Prices for artwork are as follows and includes a \$25 processing fee:

Metal plate photo (per photo):

- 4 x 6 inches: \$100 (\$50 for duplicates)
- 5 x 7: \$125 (\$50 for duplicates)
- 8 x 10: \$150 (\$75 for duplicates)
- 11 x 14: \$175 (\$100 for duplicates)

Etched plate:

- Up to 10.5 x 13.5 inches: \$150
- 11 x 14 to 20 x 28: \$275

Please Note

- Price includes a seven-foot aluminum post (two square-section posts for corporation markers), set screws, and prepaid shipping.
- Replacement posts: \$325 for 7 foot post and \$350 for 10 foot post
